**HARBOR CRUISE** – Step aboard the Harbor Queen for a narrated cruise of historic Annapolis harbor and the banks of the U.S. Naval Academy. Enjoy getting on the water and catching a glimpse of the Bay Bridges. Beverages and snacks available for purchase. The Harbor Queen has restrooms. Group minimum: 30 guests.

**US NAVAL ACADEMY** – Start your visit at the Armel Leftwich Visitors Center. Enjoy the free 12-minute film, exhibits and gift shop. Then join your tour guides for a historical walking tour that describes life at the U.S. Naval Academy, past and present. Allow 2 hours for the Visitors Center and walking tour.

**GORGEOUS GARDENS** – Your group will enjoy our trolley tour focusing on 18th century garden and landscape design: plane geometry, manipulating perspective, fences in the urban setting, some of the social history, and where colonial gardeners obtained their plants. The trolley will deliver you to the William Paca Gardens - a two-acre colonial urban garden unusual for combining both formal and natural styles.

**TOUR & TEA** – Pair your trolley tour of Annapolis with an authentic British tea at Reynolds Tavern (circa 1747), lovingly restored and beautifully decorated. Reynolds serves up tea as simple or elaborate as your time and tastes allow. Or make Reynolds your first choice for lunch, with great soups, sandwiches, salads, and heartier fare.
